#### **AVAILABILITY**

This schedule is for electric service to residential customers with electric space heating. New customers after April 1, 2016, must have a heat pump.

Where the electric heat equipment is separately metered for customers served prior to April 1, 2016, the Cooperative may separately calculate the bill for the separately metered heating equipment under this tariff and add to the remainder of the customer's usage as billed under the Residential rate, provided that only one Service Availability Charge per location shall be billed per month. Customers that were previously served on the Load Management tariff are grandfathered into this tariff as described below.

This rate may be closed to new customers at any time by a vote of the Cooperative Board of Trustees without further notice.

Alternating current, 60 Hz (cycle), single phase, at available secondary voltages not to exceed 240 volts.

#### **SEASONS**

The winter season shall begin after the October meter reading and continue through the June meter reading.

The summer season shall begin after the June meter reading and continue through the October meter reading.

#### MINIMUM BILL

The minimum bill per month will be the Service Availability Charge or part thereof.

# **BILLING COST ADJUSTMENTS**

Energy sales under this schedule are subject to all billing adjustments including but not limited to the Power Cost Adjustment (Schedule PCA) and the Property Tax Adjustment (Schedule PTA).

# **DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND**

The billing demand shall be the peak monthly demand as established each month by an indicating or a recording demand meter for 15 consecutive minutes and may be adjusted for power factor and shall be rounded to the next full kW.

# OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Service shall be rendered under the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations.

Electric space cooling and electric space heating shall be an approved installation designed to operate at 240 volts single phase and shall be permanently installed.

#### **PAYMENT**

All bills for service are due and payable in accordance with the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations.
